

Presentation #4 – Tell us how to do something

Give a short talk (5-10 minutes) telling us how to do something that you know how to do.

You can choose anything you want. Some examples:

How to sew a pair of pants, tie a special knot, change the oil in your car, drive a car with a stick shift, get a driver's license, get certified for a special job, ship a box of food to another country, swim, start a fire, ride a bicycle, plant a tree, build a table, etc.

Think about how to explain this clearly to someone who might not know how to do it.

Some things to include in your talk:

- What materials do you need?
- Do you have to go someplace special to do this?
- How do you get started?
- What do you do next? What do you do after that? Break it down into steps.

- How long does it take?
- How much do the materials cost?
- Bring materials if you want to show us, but the important thing is to tell us.
